1. IMPORTANCE OF INTENTION

عَنْ عُمَرَ بْنِ الْخَطَّابِ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ عَلَى الْمَنِيرِ قَالَ سَمِعْتُ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ ﷺ يَقُولُ: إِنَّمَا الْأَعْمَالُ بِالنِّيَّاتِ وَإِنَّمَا لِكُلِّ امْرِئٍ مَّا نَوَى، فَمَنْ كَانَتْ هِجْرَتُهُ إِلَى دُنْيَا يُصِيبُهَا أَوْ إِلَى امْرَأَةٍ يَنْكِحُهَا فَهِجْرَتُهُ إِلَى مَا هَاجَرَ إِلَيْهِ. Narrated 'Umar bin Al-Khattab (رضي الله عنه): I heard Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) saying, "The reward of deeds depends upon the intentions and every person will get the reward according to what he has intended. So whoever emigrated for worldly benefits or for a woman to marry, his emigration was for what he emigrated for."

2. FOUNDATIONS OF ISLAM

عَنْ ابْنِ عُمَرَ قَالَ قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ ﷺ: بُنِيَ الْإِسْلَامُ عَلَى خَمْسٍ شَهَادَةِ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ، وَأَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا رَسُولُ اللَّهِ، وَإِقَامِ الصَّلَاةِ، وَإِيتَاءِ الزَّكَاةِ، وَالْحَجِّ، وَصَوْمِ رَمَضَانَ. [كتاب الايمان: 8]

Narrated Ibn 'Umar (رضي الله عنهما): Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said: Islam is based on (the following) five (principles):

- To testify that none has the right to be worshipped but Allah and Muhammad is Allah's Messenger (ﷺ).

- To offer the (compulsory congregational) prayers dutifully and perfectly.
- To pay Zakat (i.e. obligatory charity).
- To perform Ḥajj. (i.e. Pilgrimage to Mecca)
- To observe fast during the month of Ramadan.

3. TAWHĪD

Narrated ‘Abdullah (رضي الله عنه): Allah’s Messenger (صلى الله عليه وسلم) said, "Anyone who dies worshipping others along with Allah will definitely enter the Fire." I said, "Anyone who dies worshipping none along with Allah will definitely enter Paradise."

4. DESTRUCTIVE SINS

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ: أَنَّ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ: اجْتَنِبُوا الْمُؤَبَقَاتِ: الشِّرْكَ بِاللَّهِ وَالسِّحْرُ. [كتاب الطب: 5764]

Narrated Abu Hurairah (رضي الله عنه): Allah’s Messenger (صلى الله عليه وسلم) said, "Avoid the *mūbiqāt*, i.e., shirk and witchcraft."

5. OBEYING THE MESSENGER

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ يَقُولُ: إِنَّ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ ﷺ قَالَ: مَنْ أَطَاعَنِي فَقَدْ أَطَاعَ اللَّهَ، وَمَنْ عَصَانِي فَقَدْ عَصَى اللَّهَ، وَمَنْ أَطَاعَ أَمِيرِي فَقَدْ أَطَاعَنِي، وَمَنْ عَصَى أَمِيرِي فَقَدْ عَصَانِي.

6. LOVE FOR THE PROPHET

Narrated Anas (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ﷺ) said "None of you will have faith till he loves me more than his father, his children and all mankind."

7. ṢALAH

عَنْ عَبْدِ اللَّهِ قَالَ: سَأَلْتُ النَّبِيَّ ﷺ أَيُّ الْعَمَلِ أَحَبُّ إِلَيَّ اللَّهُ؟ قَالَ: الصَّلَاةُ عَلَيَّ وَقْتِهَا، قَالَ: ثُمَّ أَيُّ؟ قَالَ: بِرُّ الْوَالِدَيْنِ، قَالَ: ثُمَّ أَيُّ؟ قَالَ: الْجِهَادُ فِي سَبِيلِ اللَّهِ. [كتاب مواقيت الصلاة: 527]

Narrated ‘Abdullah (رضي الله عنه): I asked the Prophet (ﷺ) "Which deed is the dearest to Allah?" He replied, "To offer the prayers at their early stated fixed times." I asked, "What is the next (in goodness)?" He replied, "To be good and dutiful to your parents" I again asked, "What is the next (in goodness)?" He replied, "To participate in Jihad in Allah's cause." ‘Abdullah added, "I asked only that much and if I had asked more, the Prophet (ﷺ) would have told me more."

8. CONGREGATIONAL ṢALĀḤ

عَنْ عَبْدِ اللَّهِ بْنِ عُمَرَ: أَنَّ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ: صَلَاةُ الْجَمَاعَةِ تَفْضُلُ صَلَاةَ الْفَذِّ بِسَبْعٍ وَعِشْرِينَ دَرَجَةً. [كتاب الاذان: 645]

Narrated ‘Abdullah bin ‘Umar: Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said, "The prayer in congregation is twenty seven times superior to the prayer offered by person alone."

9. ‘ASR ṢALĀḤ

عَنْ عَبْدِ اللَّهِ بْنِ عُمَرَ أَنَّ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ: الَّذِي تَفُوتُهُ صَلَاةَ الْعَصْرِ فَكَأَنَّمَا وُتِرَ أَهْلُهُ وَمَالُهُ. [كتاب مواقيت الصلاة: 552]

Narrated Ibn ‘Umar (رضي الله عنه): Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said, "Whoever misses the ‘Asr prayer (intentionally) then it is as if he lost his family and property."

10. EXPIATION OF FORGETTING PRAYER

عَنْ أَنَسِ بْنِ مَالِكٍ عَنِ النَّبِيِّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ: مَنْ نَسِيَ صَلَاةً فَلْيَصِلْ إِذَا ذَكَرَ، لَا كَفَّارَةَ لَهَا إِلَّا ذَلِكَ. [كتاب مواقيت الصلاة: 597]

Narrated Anas (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "If anyone forgets a prayer he should pray that prayer when he remembers it. There is no expiation except to pray the same." Then he recited: "Establish prayer for My (i.e. Allah's) remembrance." [20:14].

11. ATTACK OF SHAYṬĀN DURING PRAYER

عَنْ عَائِشَةَ قَالَتْ: سَأَلْتُ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ عَنِ الْإِتْفَاتِ فِي الصَّلَاةِ فَقَالَ: هُوَ اخْتِلَاسٌ يَحْتَلِسُ الشَّيْطَانُ مِنْ صَلَاةِ الْعَبْدِ. [كتاب الاذان: 751]

Narrated 'Aisha (رضي الله عنها): I asked Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) about looking hither and thither in prayer. He replied, "It is a way of stealing by which Satan takes away (a portion) from the prayer of a person."

12. ZAKĀT

عَنْ جَرِيرِ بْنِ عَبْدِ اللَّهِ، قَالَ: بَايَعْتُ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ عَلَى إِقَامِ الصَّلَاةِ، وَإِيتَاءِ الزَّكَاةِ، وَالتَّصْحِيحِ لِكُلِّ مُسْلِمٍ. [كتاب الايمان: 57]

Narrated Jarir bin 'Abdullah (رضي الله عنه): I gave the pledge of allegiance to Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) for the following:

-
1. Offer prayers perfectly
 2. Pay the Zakat (obligatory charity) and
 3. Be sincere and true to every Muslim.

13. DO NOT LOOK DOWN ON CHARITY

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ عَنِ النَّبِيِّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ: يَا نِسَاءَ الْمُسْلِمَاتِ لَا تَحْقِرَنَّ جَارَةً لِحَارَتِهَا وَلَوْ فَرِسَنَ شَاةٍ.

The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "O Muslim women! None of you should look down upon the gift sent by her female neighbor even if it were the trotters of the sheep (fleshless part of legs)."

14. CHARITY WITH RELUCTANCE

عَنْ أَسْمَاءَ: أَنَّ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ: أَنْفِقِي وَلَا تُحْصِي فِيْ حِصِّيَ اللَّهُ عَلَيْكَ وَلَا تُوعِي فِيْ وَعِيِ اللَّهِ عَلَيْكَ.

[كتاب الهبة وفضلها والتحريض عليها: 2591]

Narrated Asma (رضي الله عنها): Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said, "Give (in charity) and do not give reluctantly lest Allah should give you in a limited amount; and do not withhold your money lest Allah should withhold it from you."

15. REWARD OF CHARITY FOR WOMEN

عَنْ عَائِشَةَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهَا قَالَتْ قَالَ النَّبِيُّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ: إِذَا أَطْعَمَتِ الْمَرْأَةُ مِنْ بَيْتِ زَوْجِهَا غَيْرَ مُفْسِدَةٍ لَهَا أَجْرُهَا، وَلَهُ مِثْلُهُ، وَلِلْخَازِنِ مِثْلُ ذَلِكَ، لَهُ بِمَا كَتَسَبَ وَلَهَا بِمَا أَنْفَقَتْ.

Narrate 'Aisha (رضي الله عنها): The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "If a woman gives meals (in charity) from her husband's house without spoiling her husband's property, she will get a reward and her husband will also get a reward likewise. The husband will get a reward because of his earnings and the woman because of her spending."

16. CHARITY

عَنْ عَدِيِّ بْنِ حَاتِمٍ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ: سَمِعْتُ النَّبِيَّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ يَقُولُ: اتَّقُوا النَّارَ وَلَوْ بِشِقِّ تَمْرَةٍ.

[كتاب الزكاة: 1417]

Narrated 'Adi bin Hatim (رضي الله عنه) heard the Prophet (ﷺ) saying: "Save yourself from Hell-fire even by giving half a date-fruit in charity."

17. VIRTUES OF TRUSTWORTHY TREASURER

عَنْ أَبِي مُوسَى الْأَشْعَرِيِّ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ: قَالَ النَّبِيُّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ: الْخَازِنُ الْأَمِينُ الَّذِي يُؤَدِّي مَا أَمَرَ بِهِ طَيِّبٌ نَفْسُهُ أَحَدُ الْمُتَصَدِّقِينَ.

Narrated Abu Musa al-Ash'ari (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "The honest treasurer who gives willingly what he is ordered to give, is one of the two charitable persons, (the second being the owner).

18. IMPORTANCE OF SPENDING ON FAMILY

عَنْ أَبِي مَسْعُودٍ عَنِ النَّبِيِّ ﷺ قَالَ: إِذَا أَنْفَقَ الرَّجُلُ عَلَى أَهْلِهِ
يُحْتَسِبُهَا فَهُوَ لَهُ صَدَقَةٌ. [كتاب الايمان: 55]

Narrated Abu Mas'ud (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "If a man spends on his family (with the intention of having a reward from Allah) sincerely for Allah's sake then it is a (kind of) alms-giving in reward for him.

19. THE BEST CHARITY

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ: أَنَّ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ ﷺ قَالَ: خَيْرُ الصَّدَقَةِ مَا كَانَ عَنْ
ظَهْرٍ غَنِيٍّ وَابْدَأَ بِمَنْ تَعُولُ. [صحيح البخارى، كتاب النفقات: 5356]

Narrated Abu Hurairah (رضي الله عنه): Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said, "The best alms is that which you give when you are rich, and you should start first to support your dependents."

20. REWARD OF HAJJ

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ: سَمِعْتُ النَّبِيَّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ يَقُولُ: مَنْ حَجَّ لِلَّهِ فَلَمْ يَرْفُثْ وَلَمْ يَفْسُقْ رَجَعَ كَيَوْمِ وَلَدَتْهُ أُمُّهُ.

[كتاب الحج:1521]

Narrated Abu Hurairah (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Whoever performs Hajj for Allah's pleasure and does not have sexual relations with his wife, and does not do evil or sins then he will return (after Hajj free from all sins) as if he were born anew."

21. ACCEPTED HAJJ

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ: أَنَّ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ سُئِلَ: أَيُّ الْعَمَلِ أَفْضَلُ؟ فَقَالَ: إِيْمَانٌ بِاللَّهِ وَرَسُولِهِ، قِيلَ: ثُمَّ مَاذَا؟ قَالَ: الْجِهَادُ فِي سَبِيلِ اللَّهِ، قِيلَ: ثُمَّ مَاذَا؟ قَالَ: حَجٌّ مَبْرُورٌ. [كتاب الايمان:26]

Narrated Abu Hurairah (رضي الله عنه): Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) was asked, "What is the best deed?" He replied, "To believe in Allah and His Apostle (Muhammad). The questioner then asked, "What is the next (in goodness)? He replied, "To participate in Jihad (religious fighting) in Allah's Cause." The questioner again asked, "What is the next (in goodness)?" He replied, "To perform Hajj *Mabrūr*, (which is accepted by Allah and is performed with the intention of seeking Allah's pleasure only and not to show off and without committing a sin and in accordance with the traditions of the Prophet (ﷺ))."

22. FASTING IN RAMADAN

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ قَالَ، قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ ﷺ: مَنْ صَامَ رَمَضَانَ إِيمَانًا وَ
احْتِسَابًا غُفِرَ لَهُ مَا تَقَدَّمَ مِنْ ذَنْبِهِ. [كتاب الايمان:38]

Narrated Abu Hurairah (رضي الله عنه): Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said, "Whoever observes fasts during the month of Ramadan out of sincere faith, and hoping to attain Allah's rewards, then all his past sins will be forgiven."

23. SUHŪR

عَنْ أَنَسِ بْنِ مَالِكٍ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ، قَالَ: قَالَ النَّبِيُّ ﷺ: تَسَحَّرُوا
فَإِنَّ فِي السُّحُورِ بَرَكَاتًا. [صحیح البخاری، کتاب الصوم:1923]

Narrated Anas bin Malik (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Take Suhur as there is a blessing in it."

24. QIYĀM IN RAMADAN

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ: أَنَّ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ ﷺ قَالَ: مَنْ قَامَ رَمَضَانَ إِيمَانًا وَ
احْتِسَابًا غُفِرَ لَهُ مَا تَقَدَّمَ مِنْ ذَنْبِهِ. [كتاب الايمان:37]

Narrated Abu Hurairah (رضي الله عنه): Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said: "Whoever establishes prayers during the nights of Ramadan faithfully out of sincere faith and hoping to attain Allah's rewards (not for showing off), all his past sins will be forgiven."

25. AVOID LYING WHILE FASTING

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ، قَالَ: قَالَ النَّبِيُّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ: مَنْ لَمَّ يَدَعُ
قَوْلَ الزُّورِ وَالْعَمَلَ بِهِ، فَلَيْسَ لِلَّهِ حَاجَةٌ فِي أَنْ يَدَعَ طَعَامَهُ
وَشَرَابَهُ. [كتاب الصوم: 1903]

Narrated Abu Hurairah (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Whoever does not give up forged speech and evil actions, Allah is not in need of his leaving his food and drink (i.e. Allah will not accept his fasting.)"

26. UNDERSTANDING OF RELIGION

عَنْ مُعَاوِيَةَ يَقُولُ: قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ: مَنْ يُسْرِدِ اللَّهُ بِهِ خَيْرًا
يُفَقِّهَهُ فِي الدِّينِ. [كتاب فرض الخمس: 3116]

Narrated Muawiyah (رضي الله عنه): Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said, "If Allah wants to do good for somebody, he makes him comprehend the Religion (i.e. Islam), and Allah is the Giver and I am Al-Qasim (i.e. the distributor), and this (Muslim) nation will remain victorious over their opponents, till Allah's Order comes and they will still be victorious."

27. SETTING OUT IN THE WAY OF ALLAH

عَنْ عُبَايَةَ بْنِ رِفَاعَةَ قَالَ: أَدْرَكَنِي أَبُو عَبْسٍ وَأَنَا أَذْهَبُ إِلَى
الْجُمُعَةِ فَقَالَ: سَمِعْتُ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ يَقُولُ: مَنْ اغْبَرَّتْ قَدَمَاهُ
فِي سَبِيلِ اللَّهِ حَرَّمَهُ اللَّهُ عَلَى النَّارِ. [صحيح البخارى، كتاب الجمعة: 907]

Narrated 'Abayah bin Rifa'ah (/) that I was going for Friday Prayer when I met Abu `Abs (رضي الله عنه) (i.e. 'Abdur Rahman bin Jabr). He said, I heard the Prophet (ﷺ) saying, "Anyone whose feet are covered with dust in Allah's cause, shall be saved by Allah from the Hell-Fire."

28. SPREADING RELIGION

عَنْ عَبْدِ اللَّهِ بْنِ عَمْرٍو أَنَّ النَّبِيَّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ: بَلِّغُوا عَنِّي وَلَوْ آيَةً
وَاحِدَةً عَنْ بَنِي إِسْرَائِيلَ وَلَا حَرَجَ ، وَمَنْ كَذَبَ عَلَيَّ مُتَعَمِّدًا
فَلْيَتَّبِعُوا مَقْعَدَهُ مِنَ النَّارِ. [كتاب أحاديث الأنبياء: 3461]

Narrated 'Abdullah bin 'Amr (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Convey (my teachings) to the people even if it were a single sentence, and tell others the stories of Bani Israel (which have been taught to you), for it is not sinful to do so. And whoever tells a lie on me intentionally, will surely take his place in the (Hell) Fire."

29. LEARNING AND TEACHING QUR'AN

عَنْ عُثْمَانَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ عَنِ النَّبِيِّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ: خَيْرُكُمْ مَنْ تَعَلَّمَ
الْقُرْآنَ وَعَلَّمَهُ. [كتاب فضائل القرآن: 5027]

Narrated 'Uthman (رضي الله عنه): The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "The best among you (Muslims) are those who learn the Qur'an and teach it."

30. RECITING BEAUTIFULLY

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ قَالَ: قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ: لَيْسَ مِنَّا مَنْ لَمْ يَتَعَنَّ بِالْقُرْآنِ. [كتاب التوحيد: 7527]

Narrated Abu Salamah (رضي الله عنه): Abu Hurairah (رضي الله عنه) said, "Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said, 'Whoever does not recite Qur'an in a nice voice is not from us.'"

31. WORTHY OF BEING ENVIED

يَمْسَحُهُ بِيَمِينِهِ: اذْهَبِ الْبَاسَ رَبَّ النَّاسِ وَاشْفِ أَنْتَ الشَّافِي
لَا شِفَاءَ إِلَّا شِفَاؤُكَ، شِفَاءً لَا يُعَادِرُ سَقَمًا. [كتاب الطب: 5750]

Narrated 'Aisha (رضي الله عنها) The Prophet (ﷺ) used to treat some of his wives by passing his right hand over the place of ailment and used to say, "O Lord of the people! Remove the difficulty and bring about healing as You are the Healer. There is no healing but Your Healing, a healing that will leave no ailment."
