for Jumu'ah should bathe." [Ṣaḥīḥ al-Bukharī]

Delivering the Sermon while Standing

'Abdullah bin 'Umar marrates that the Prophet delivered the sermon while standing then sat (after the first sermon), then he would stand as you do at present." [Ṣaḥīḥ al-Bukhārī]

Sitting Between the Two Sermons

'Abdullah bin Umar Abdullah bi

Listening Attentively to the Sermon

Abū Hurairah arrated that the Prophet aid, "If you (even) ask your companion to be quiet on Jumu'ah while the Imām is delivering the sermon you have in fact talked irrelevance [i.e., engaged in idle talk]." [Ṣaḥiḥ al-Bukhārī]

Sitting Posture

Mu'adh bin Anas narrated, "While the Imam is delivering the sermon on Jumu'ah, the Messenger of Allah prohibited to sit in a posture where the legs are propped up and drawn towards the stomach and are embraced with the arms." [Abū Dawud]

Arriving When the Sermon has Started

Jabir bin 'Abdullah an narrated that a person entered the mosque while the Prophet was delivering the sermon on a Jumu'ah. The Prophet said to him, "Have you prayed?" The man replied in the negative. The Prophet said, "Get up and pray two Rak at." [Sahih al-Bukhari]

Rak 'at after Jumu'ah Prayer

'Abdullah bin 'Umar marrates that the Prophet is offered two Rak at before Zuhr and two after it, two Rak at after Maghrib in his house, two Rak at after Isha' and he read nothing after Jumu'ah prayer until he returned home and offered two Rak at. [Saḥiḥ al-Bukhari]

Abu Hurairah arrated that the Prophet said,

"When you have performed the Jumu'ah prayer then offer four Rak at" [Ṣaḥāḥ Muslim]

So it is a *Masnun* act to perform both two or four *Rak at* of prayer after the Jumu'ah prayer at home, however, they can also be offered in the mosque.

Warning for not Offering Jumu'ah Prayer

Ibn 'Umar and Abū Hurairah heard Allah's Messenger say on the planks of his pulpit, "People must cease to neglect the Jumu'ah prayer or Allah will seal their hearts and then they will be among the negligent."

[Şahīh Muslim]

Ibn Masud an narrated that the Prophet said to the people who stayed away from the Jumu'ah prayer, "I have thought about commanding a man to lead the people in prayer, then burning the houses of men who stayed away from the Jumu'ah prayer." [Saḥīḥ Muslim]

Worship in the Night of Jumu'ah

Jabir an narrated that the Prophet said, "Do not exclusively choose the night of Jumu'ah [night between Thursday and Friday] as a special night for performing the night prayers. Also, do not exclusively choose Friday as a day of fasting unless it occurs on a day that you regularly fast." [Saḥiḥ Muslim]

Fasting on Friday

Jabir narrated that the Prophet said, "Do not fast on Friday unless you fast on it together with the day before or the day after it."

[Sahih al-Bukhari]

Friday - A Fine Combination

Friday is a day of worship for the Muslims, but they have also been allowed to fulfill their worldly tasks in times other than that of the prayer.

Allah savs,

فَاذَ اقُضِيَتِ الصَّلُواةُ فَانْتَشِرُوافِي الْاَرُضِ وَابُتَغُوامِنُ فَضُلِ اللَّهِ وَاذْكُرُ وااللَّهَ كَثِيرًا لَّعَلَّكُمُ تُفُلِحُونَ.

"And when the prayer has been concluded, disperse within the land and seek from the bounty of Allah, and remember Allah often that you may succeed." [Al-Jumu'ah: 10]

Henceforth, the Muslims have been told to pray for the goodness of this world alongside the hereafter.

رَبَّنَ الْتِنَا فِي اللَّانَيَ احَسَنَةً وَّ فِي الْأَخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَّ فِي الْأَخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَاعَذَابَ النَّارِ.

"Our Lord, give us in this world [that which is] good and in the Hereafter [that which is] good and protect us from the punishment of the Fire." [Al-Baqarah: 201]

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Friday a Blessed Day

Friday, A Blessed Day

umu'ah (Friday) is the day of collective worship and celebration. A narration of 'Abdullah bin 'Abbas wand Abu Mas'ud shows that the command regarding the obligation of praying the Jumu'ah prayer was revealed in Makkah just before migration. However, this command could not be implemented because it was not possible for the Muslims to perform prayer in congregation in Makkah. Nonetheless, the Prophet dispatched an order to the people of Madinah to perform the Jumu'ah prayer while he was still in Makkah. So Mus'ab bin 'Umair , along with twelve men, established the first Jumu'ah prayer in Madinah. The Prophet himself offered the first Jumu'ah prayer in the village of Banu Salim bin 'Awf with a hundred men during his migration journey from Makkah to Madinah.

Abu Hurairah narrated that Allah's Messenger as said, "The best day on which the sun has risen is Jumu'ah; on it Adam was created, on it he was brought into Paradise, on it he was expelled from it, and the Day of Resurrection will also take place on this day." [Sahih Muslim]

Masnun Acts of Jumu'ah

Ghusl (Bath), Siwak (Tooth Stick) and Perfume

Abū Sa'id al-Khudri narrated that Allah's Messenger said, "The taking of a bath on Friday is compulsory for every male (Muslim) who has attained the age of puberty." [Sahih al-Bukhari]

Abū Sa'id al-Khudrī was narrated, "I testify that Allah's Messenger a said, The taking of a bath on Jumu'ah is compulsory for every male Muslim who has attained the age of puberty and (also) the cleaning of his teeth with Siwak, and the using of perfume if it is available." [Sahih al-Bukhari]

Salman al-Farsi narrated that the Prophet said, "Whoever takes a bath on Jumu'ah, purifies himself as much as he can, then uses his (hair) oil or perfumes himself with the scent of his house, then proceeds (for the Jumu'ah prayer) and does not separate two persons sitting together (in the mosque), then prays as much as (Allah is has) written for him and then remains silent while the Imam is delivering the sermon, his sins in between the present and the last Friday would be forgiven." [Sahih al-Bukhari]

Sending Abundant Blessings upon the Prophet 2

Aws ibn Aws arrated that the Prophet said, "Among the most excellent of your days is Jumu'ah; on it Adam was created, on it he died, on it the last trumpet will be blown, and on it the shout will be made, so invoke more blessings on me that day, for your blessings will be submitted to me." [Abu Dawud]

Reciting Surah Al-Kahf

Abu Sa'id al-Khudri an narrated that the Prophet said, "Whoever recites Surah Al-Kahf on Jumu'ah, light shall shine forth for him from one Jumu'ah to the next." [Saḥiḥ al-Targhib]

Making Supplications

Abu Hurairah an narrated that when the Prophet mentioned Jumu'ah, he said, "In it there is a particular time. If a Muslim happens to be praying and invoking Allah if for something good during that time, Allah is will surely fulfill his request." The Prophet indicated the shortness of that time with his hand.

[Sahih al-Bukhari]

According to a Hadith reported in Sahih Muslim, it is between the time when the Imam sits down and the end of the prayer. While according to a report in Sunan al-*Tirmidhi*, it is from the afternoon prayer till sunset.

The Jumu'ah Prayer

The Jumu'ah Prayer is Obligatory

It is necessary for Muslim men to offer the Jumu'ah prayer in the mosque in congregation.

Allah os says,

"O you who have believed, when [the Adhan] is called for the prayer on the day of Jumu'ah [Friday], then proceed to the remembrance of Allah and leave trade. That is better for you, if you only knew." [Al-Jumu'ah: 9]

Tarig bin Shahab win narrated that the Prophet said, "Jumu'ah prayer in congregation is a necessary duty for every Muslim, except four persons: a slave, a woman, a boy, and a sick person." [Abu Dawud]

Virtues of Praying Jumu'ah Prayer

Abu Hurairah arrated that the Prophet said, "He who took a bath and then came for Jumu'ah prayer and then prayed what was fixed for him, then kept silent till the Imam finished the sermon, and then prayed along with him, his sins between that time and the next Friday would be forgiven, and even of three days more." [Sahih Muslim]

Time of Jumu'ah Prayer

The time of Jumu'ah prayer is the same time

as that of Zuhr prayer. Anas bin Malik narrates that the Messenger of Allah a offered the Jumu'ah prayers when the sun declined (at noon. [Sahih al-Bukhari]

Coming on Time for Jumu'ah Prayer

Abu Hurairah an narrated that the Prophet said, "Any person who takes a bath on Friday like the bath of Janabah (sexual impurity) then goes for the prayer (in the first hour i.e. early), it is as if he had sacrificed a camel (in Allah's cause); and whoever goes in the second hour it is as if he had sacrificed a cow; and whoever goes in the third hour, then it is as if he had sacrificed a horned ram; and if one goes in the fourth hour, then it is as if he had sacrificed a hen; and whoever goes in the fifth hour then it is as if he had offered an egg. When the Imam comes out (i.e. starts delivering the sermon), the angels present themselves to listen to the sermon." [Sahih al-Bukhari]

Place of Sitting

'Abdullah Ibn 'Umar win narrated that Allah's Messenger forbade anyone to make another (person) get up and then sit in his place.

[Sahih al-Bukhari]

'Abdullah bin Basr narrates that a man came crossing the people (over their shoulders) whereupon Allah's Messenger said (to him), "Sit down! Indeed, you have caused harm (to the people)." [Abū Dāwūd]

The Jumu'ah prayer in comparison to the Zuhr prayer is brief (two rak'at instead of four). The Jumu'ah prayer is preceded by a sermon, which comprises of two parts.

The Jumu'ah Sermon

Sermon on the Podium

'Abdullah bin 'Umar win narrates that I heard that the Prophet a was delivering the sermon on the podium and he said, "One who comes
