






































# Resolve to reach the Destitute








## **Academics Department**



# **Hifz Program**

The AIS Hifz Program is offered at a minimum age of 9 years and maximum age of 11 years, with segregated sections for boys and girls. The program's focus is to provide students with excellence in Ta'leem and Tarbiyah. Along with memorization of the Book of Allah, Tarbiyah sessions are held to help the students develop good character, manners and ethics. During the lockdown, our Hifz students appeared in their Wafaq test on July 12th 2020. By the grace of Allah (SWT) 9 outstanding students received the 'Mumtaz' grade in their Wafaq test which is the highest grade in the Hifz degree.

ACS, a network of welfare schools currently operating at 8 locations in Lahore, is serving underprivileged children by providing them access to quality education and ensuring moral uplift. With classes from Montessori to Matric, ACS employs qualified staff and volunteers to provide opportunities for growth, success, high morals for every child of the community.







Our aim is to uplift our students both educationally and morally. We provide all kind of support to our students including books, uniforms, and infrastructure. In some areas lunch and ration is also provided. We strive to make access to free education possible for every child.





#### Our Achievements Progress and New Initiatives

#### **Tarbiyah Classes:**

Youth club offered Tarbiyah classes for young ones. Youth club is working on Tarbiyah as well as personal grooming and communication skills of our children.

#### Health and Hygiene Club:

A team from Fatima Memorial Hospital Nutrition Department visited Al-Huda Community Schools for medical camp. They talked on the topic of "Hygiene and Healthy Food". They motivated the students on effectiveness of healthy food. The team of doctors gave a proper guidance and a follow up was arranged by Sunabal Health Services.

#### Tree Planting Week:

Students participated in all these activities very enthusiastically. They have learned the importance of plants. They planted approximately 400 plants in all.

#### Field Trips:

Educational trips for all the students were planned to the nearest recreational places but could not be taken due to Covid Lock down.

ACS management and staff adapted the new ways of teaching and educating the students by making a successful and big online setup. ACS tried its best to spread awareness and educated its staff, parents, and teachers to keep themselves safe during this pandemic.






### **Training**




## Mosque Projects

# Emergency Response to Earthquake Disaster at Jatlan, Mirpur Azad Jammu Kashmir

A powerful earthquake jolted several parts of Pakistan Administered Kashmir on 24 September 2019 at 4.02pm local time, particularly areas of Azad Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab, and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The earthquake severely affected Jatlan in Mirpur district, Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

According to the US Geological Survey (USGS), the 5.8 magnitude earthquake struck at a shallow depth of 10 kilometers with its epicenter lying one kilometer southeast of Mirpur, Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

Al-Huda International responded to this emergency to support the community of the badly affected area. We have also our branch located in the same area.

There are a number of villages hit by the earthquake. Al-Huda provided support to locals in form of;

## Qurbani Project

## **Project Overview:**

Qurbani lexically means something through which one can approach Allah. As it is understood from the word sacrifice (qurban) is an opportunity to be close to Allah and to gain his consent.

Allah states the following in the Chapter al-Hajj: "It is not their meat nor their blood that reaches Allah: it is your piety that reaches Him." (22/37). Accordingly, it is understood that the real aim of sacrificing an animal is to fulfill the order of Allah and show that one fears Allah. It means we can sacrifice even our most valuable things if Allah asks us. The aim is to show that we can even sacrifice our lives just like Hazrat Ibrahim (Abraham) who decided to sacrifice his son, Ismail (Ishmael). In a sense, qurban means we can get rid of the feeling of loving worldly possessions and sacrifice everything for the sake of Allah SWT.

Hazrat Abu Hurairah reports that the Apostle of Allah has said: "Whoever has the capacity to sacrifice and does not do so, should not come to the place where the Eid prayer is offered." (Ibn Majah).

## **Qurbani** Objective:

- Enlivening Sunnah of Ibrahim (A.S).
- Distribution of meat to the needy families involving regions and their respected branches.
- Bringing People closer to Allah (SWT).
- Vulnerable: women, children and elderly by providing them with meat at least once in a year.

## **Project Description:**

Qurbani distribution project for the year 2019 is the yearly based activity which Al- Huda International Welfare Foundation is performing from last many years. With the past experience the Foundation has developed a great experience and understanding the needs of deserving in the communities.

The target area of this specific activity starts from desert areas of Tharparker (Sindh), to the barren lands of Interior Sind and Baluchistan covering the regions of Multan, Rahimyar Khan, Lahore in Punjab and to the hilly areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa including Chitral and Azad Jamu and Kashmir

- 11) Circulation of approved final Qurbani 2019 activity closing report.






## Allocation of Animals Region wise:







# IT Department (websites, Apps & Servers)

#### Overview:

The IT Department serves as the backbone of all modern organizations. This is why it enjoys paramount status in the 21st century. Its significance came to the fore particularly in the beginning of this year when the world found itself in the midst of the corona pandemic. Against this backdrop, Al-Huda international's IT Department too has been engaged in providing varying services to different stakeholders from time to time. At the start of the year, Al-Huda faced a system breakdown which restricted students' access to Al-Huda's online video library. Primary cause of this was a fault in the underwater internet backbone cable which connects European and Asian countries. Its impact was predominant for students from India and Pakistan. Keeping in view the gravity of the situation and importance of the online video library, the IT department after days of hard work, developed a custom, cost effective solution. It first involved gathering stats of students from world over after which it was ascertained that majority of them belong to US, Canada, UK, Pakistan and India. Then, to avoid such a situation from arising in the future, we decided to set up Data Service infrastructure in 3 countries, namely, India, US and UK, which would ensure reliable connectivity from Data Service setups in 2 countries if there was a breakdown in one of them. This venture proved to be quite fruitful.

In any case, the field of IT is such that it requires frequent up gradation. Therefore, the institution has shifted all its websites on its new servers after making proper arrangements for cyber security, covering all angles.

When Covid peaked, negatively affecting children's' education, the importance of online education was highlighted. The organization had already introduced a website by the name of Alhuda (www.e-alhuda.com) along with some mobile apps .Hence, we introduced this feature by integrating Zoom with our own mobile app, paving the way for live sessions. At any specified time, students can now be part of an online class through the click of a button.

The organization has also introduced several other apps in the past among which 'Learn Quran', Al-Huda Live' and 'Quran in Hand' stand out.






