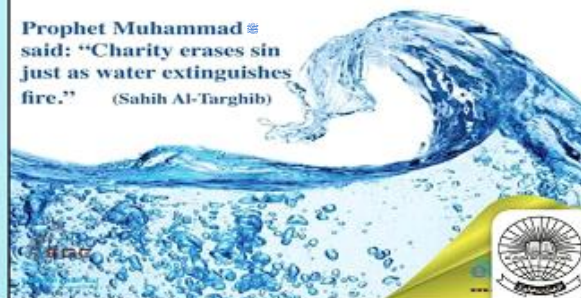

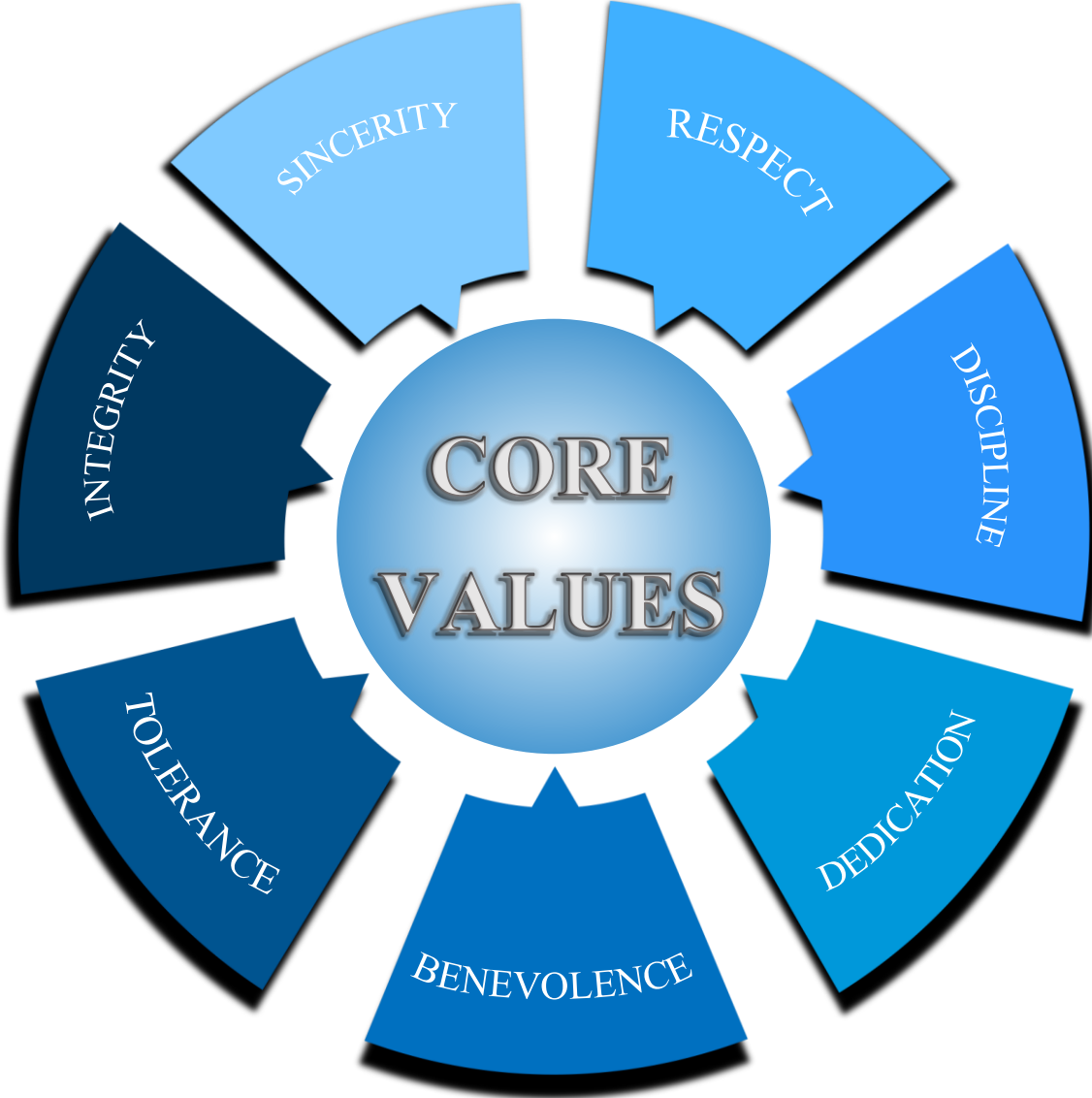

## Dr. Farhat Hashmi

Founder of Al Huda

*One of the most world renowned female Islamic scholars of the century, Dr. Farhat Hashmi is today seen as an iconic figure, responsible for helping generations of Muslims develop a personal, one on one relationship with the Quran. 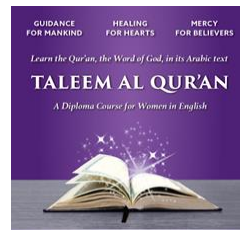

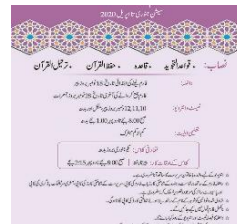

## Key Milestones

July 2021 – June 2022

### Online courses launched by Academic Office Karachi

**3477+ people attended the 5 online courses** (Tadabbur al Qur'an Juzz 27 and Arabic Grammar) that were launched by Al-Huda Karachi academic office in the year July'21 till June '22. **Almost 3400+ people** attended the 4 Tadabbur courses (Juzz 27), as students and listeners. **763** students received course completion certificates.

### First-time courses launched through e-Learning platform from Academic office

Arabic Grammar course (conducted by Rakhshanda Khaleeq) was launched from e-Learning section in January 2022. Out of the **77** people who enrolled in it, **31** received completion certificates.

### Publicity section's work for the e-Learning platform

In the month of April 2022, **flyers were developed for the first time by Al-Huda Karachi Region team with QR codes and registration links for online payments** for the new eLearning platform.

### Basic Education Program

Number of students who completed Iqra Courses and 'Roshni Ki Kiran' and 'Roshni Ka Safar' Courses was **631**.

A Sindhi literacy project (non-formal school) was launched in Badin in village Abdul Karim Lashari with **70** students. These include **40** girls and **30** women.



## Abdul Karim Laghari Sindhi Literacy Pilot Project

6 Basic Education Programs (BEP) were conducted (including Roshni Ki Kiran, Roshni Ka Safar, and Basic vocational training) with a total of 107 students.

**Overview:** A literacy educational program is planned for the children of village Abdul Karim Laghari in District Badeen. A village of 200 households Alhuda staff from Malkani sheriff havetaught Iqra course to 30 girls.

To continue deeni taleem and also start a non-formal school here, as there is a good strength of girls/boys of around 50+ from ages 5 upto 12 years.

Syllabus: For ELP (Early Learning Program), Sindhi literacy books will be used developed by Global education.

For SLP (Sindh Literacy Program), books developed by a National Commission for Human development (NCHD) which are provided free by the government with training and teacher guides.

### Teacher Training

1. For SLP a trainer will come from NCHD and our girls from Malkani and other places will come to Karachi and have a 4 days training for teaching Sindhi literacy.
2. For ELP Global education will provide training either in Karachi or Malkani.

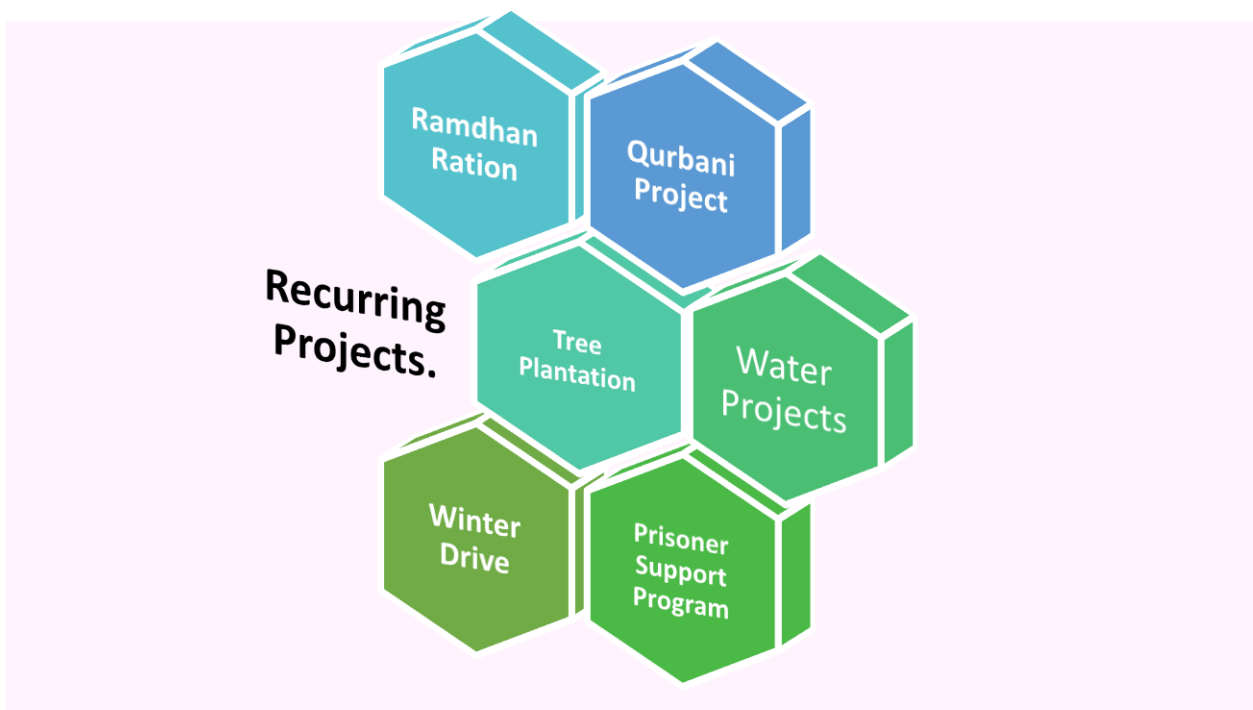
## Social Welfare Department Activities

The Social Welfare Department provides different services like, Financial Assistance, Medical Assistance, Marriage Assistance, Educational Assistance, Self-Support, Taam Ul Miskeen, Monthly Ration, and Vocational Trainings, Ghusal e Mayyeth and Takfeen, Sehat E Ama, Qarz e Hasana, and Marriage Bureau etc. Our services range from financial assistance for the deserving to funeral support services.

Regular projects are Water Projects, Tree Plantation, Winter Drive, Prisoner Support Program, and Ramadan Ration, while some of the projects are conducted on emergency basis like Flood Emergency Response Project, Earthquake Emergency Response Project, Rehabilitation Project, and Pandemic Diseases Emergency Response Project etc.

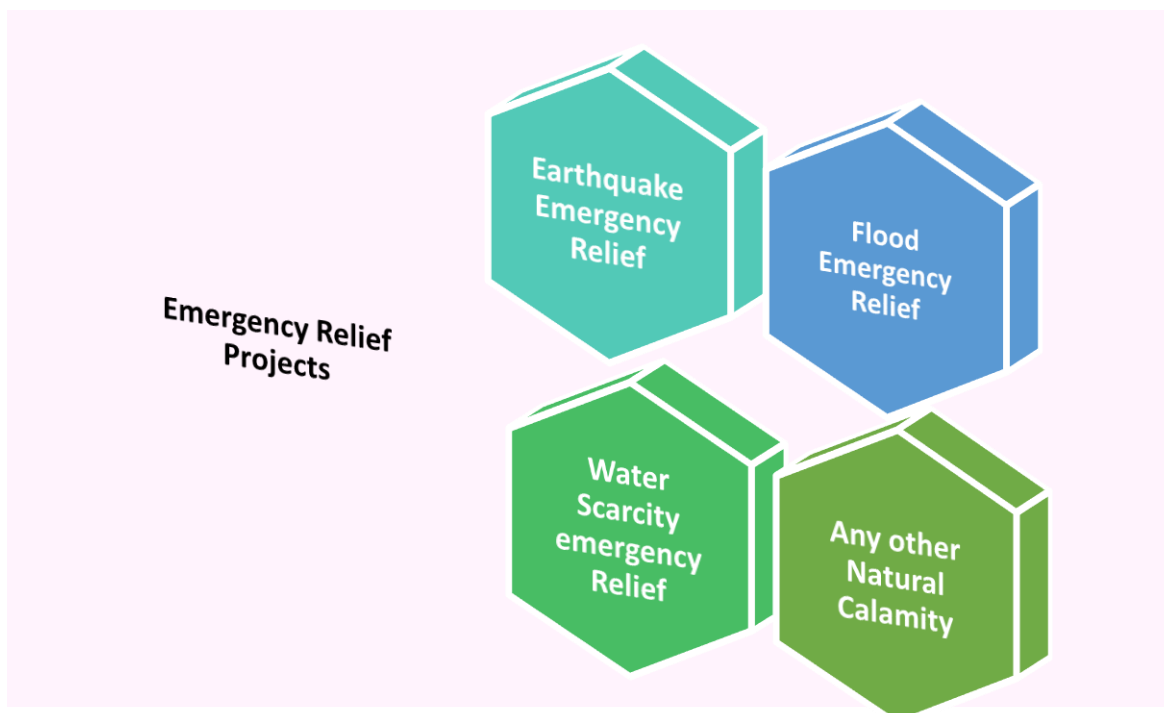
## Recurring Projects

These are the projects that happen on regular basis annually in all the regions and branches, and are monitored and executed from the Head office



## Emergency Projects

Emergency relief projects are the projects which are executed by the Al-Huda SWD for **the provision of essential needs to individuals, families and communities immediately after a natural disaster like flood, earthquake, water scarcity, and pandemic diseases etc.**



Under the umbrella of these projects different types of emergency humanitarian assistance are provided to the affected families of these natural calamities.

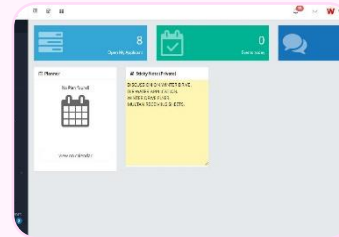

## Bannu Water Projects KPK

15 Submersible water pumps have been installed.

The sole purpose to start this project was the provision of fresh and drinkable water to the listed areas.



## Harnai Balochistan 25 One-Room Shelter House Project

On 7th October 2021 an Earthquake hit the different areas of Balochistan

It was found that the people on an emergency basis need rations, tents, blankets, etc. Later on, it was decided to work on the rehabilitation of the affectees for which a joint venture project with the Alkhidmat Foundation was launched for the installation of 25 one-room shelter houses.

## Water Project

Regional office Peshawar KPK on the request of Inspector General jails for the provision of Electric Water Coolers, Water Tanks, and Hand Pumps along with necessary equipment.

## Faraham e Aab Project across Pakistan (250 Water Coolers Installation)

A total of 250 water coolers were installed, in which 130 in Punjab, 45 in KPK, 45 in Sindh, and 30 in Balochistan were installed. The water coolers were installed in Masajids, Madrasas, Public Areas, Markets and Schools.

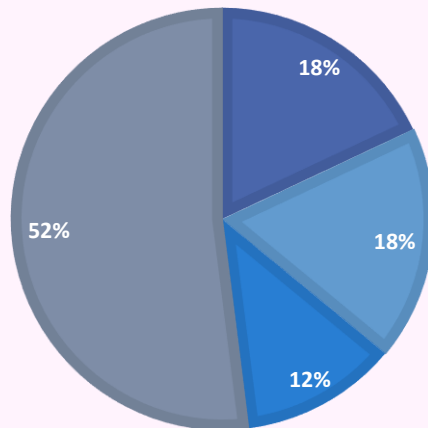

### Rehabilitation of 05 Schools Water Project At Harnai Balochistan

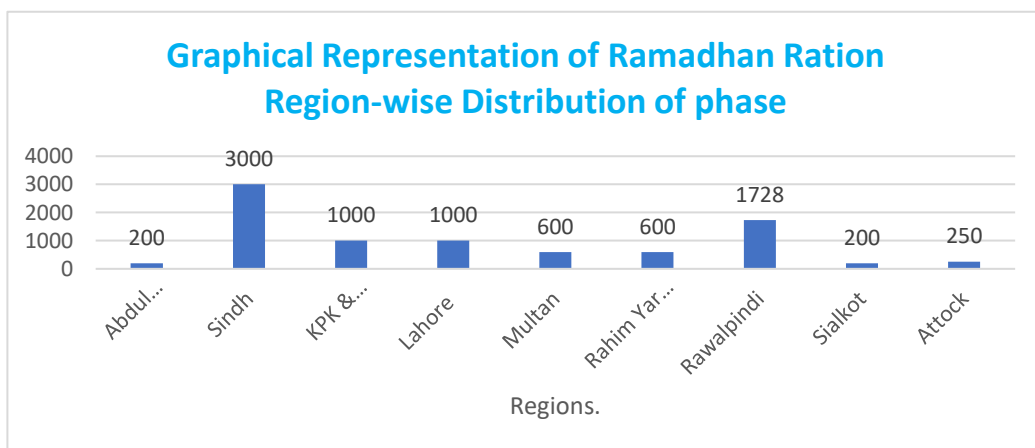
