

Al Huda International Welfare Foundation was established in 1994 under the leadership of Ustazah Doctor Farhat Naseem Hashmi one of the world's renowned female Islamic scholars of the century, Dr. Farhat Hashmi is today seen as an iconic figure, responsible for helping generations of Muslims develop a personal, one on one relationship with the Quran. She is considered as one of the most influential contemporary Muslim scholars (Ulema) today. As an orator, her lectures, and talks, which are based on authentic knowledge, are known to touch the hearts of millions, as every word she speaks is from the heart. Personally, she considers herself an "eternal student and servant of the Quran" and, more than an icon, orator, or scholar, prefers to be simply called "Ustazah" (teacher).

Today, Al-Huda International Welfare Foundation is a name synonymous with unbiased, quality Islamic education. Al-Huda is a place where any and every woman, irrespective of religion, caste or material stature, is welcomed to come and learn the true teachings of Islam. With humble beginnings, Al-Huda today has a network of branches in every continent of the world, with innumerable students who have become "Muslims by choice" and have rediscovered Islam as the way of life that guides them in every practical situation. A global wave of Quranic awareness was triggered by Dr Hashmi, and innumerable students of Dr Hashmi have, in turn, taken upon themselves the voluntary service of educating others about Islam.

She has written papers on the rights, roles, and responsibilities of a woman in the light of Quran and Sunnah and contribution of Muslim women scholars in dissemination of al-Hadith-al-Nabawi.

Dr. Hashmi is also accredited with coupling Islamic learning with a wave of revival of Islam's humanitarian spirit. Thus, Al-Huda is today also known for serving the less privileged and compromised components of society as a trusted welfare organization.




Future Plans





Online Nazra Program

The Nazrah course for kids was introduced through eLearning in 2022 and is currently operating without a hitch. My Book of Letters and flash cards were developed by a team under supervision of Ustazah. It had letters from *Alif* till *ya* with activities like colouring, circling etc.by Sumaira Akif. Students from 4 years to 6 years old joined from Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain and Australia. The teachers from Karachi, Lahore, Gujranwala and Islamabad were selected and trained by Sitara Saba, Jeddah branch In charge. She is a certified Tajweed teacher by Arab Madrassah. Team was trained and monitored closely by Sumaira Akif, who has been running her own Tajweed and Nazrah online and on campus courses and is highly competent. 


Audio Editing Department

Admin

Administration Department

Activities & Achievements:

This year Admin Department received various types of demands as per requirements from Management and Décor / other departments. These were completed accordingly. Following are the achievements and key milestones during this year.

Dismantle and concrete work of residence side area:

The issue of proper drainage at Residence site floor of rain water was long outstanding problem needs to be treated. It was decided by senior authorities to consult technical personnel to dismantle and re-concrete the area.

Installation of new chiller in hvac department:

The old HVAC chiller system is of 100 ton capacity, whereas the entire building is designed for approximately 450 tons of load. This system is not capable of providing effective cooling to the entire building. So, it was decided by competent authorities to install additional new chiller in HVAC department in basement area. Brief description of the Chiller is:

Installation of Water Softener

Water Softener was recommended by the consultant, this system removes minerals that create water hardness. The installations of pipe lines from Lower Ground Floor with Cooling Tower were connected and completed by the contractor.

Firefighting installation:

After installation of complete firefighting / sprinkle system in Al-Huda building as per CDA standards 2010 / 2016, staff Training was arranged to handle the equipment in case of emergency and drills were conducted for all departments.







Power factor repairing work:

The system was repaired by Technical Hardware Team and now working satisfactory.

Tree plantation achievement:

This year admin department specially focused on the care and maintenance of plants already planted in year 2022. These plants have already grown very well and now utilized for shelter and shades of vehicles.







Generator maintenance, fumigation in Al-Huda building area, maintenance of water coolers, resource center

Contract of sms services for aims department:

AMIS (Al-Huda Management Information System) was developed for delivery of SMS services to students of Al-Huda. Currently this service is available for Head Office, AIM, to forty-three or so branches and Regions departments.
