Quran and Sunnah and contribution of Muslim women scholars in dissemination of Islamic Education.



Its mission is to serve humanity by imparting knowledge of the Qur'an and Sunnah, and to strive for the welfare of the society









- Planned different Out Reach programs.



Areas Under KPK Region




