AL-HUDA INSTITUTE ISLAMABAD




This year, the Academic Department successfully conducted 27 courses, demonstrating dedication and innovation in facilitating student learning. Key achievements include the development of admission and sponsorship SOPs, launch of a digital transport allowance system, and implementation of a month-wise sponsorship tracking system. Efforts to enhance learning encompassed combined flyers for courses, creation of subject-wise question banks, and enriched co-curricular activities such as Hadith seminars, library-based learning, and student presentations.

The department also bolstered student welfare via expanded counseling and health services addressing physical, emotional, and spiritual wellbeing.

AL-HUDA INSTITUTE FOR MEN



Curricular and extracurricular initiatives such as archery, visits to old-age homes, student presentations, and small-group outdoor engagements promoted holistic development.



NORTH REGION



The North Region manages and monitors academic and social welfare initiatives, ensuring smooth operation of ongoing courses, organization of new classes, and access to essential educational resources for staff and students. It oversees training programs, maintains student-teacher and class records, monitors academic progress, evaluates staff performance, and tracks project outcomes


LAHORE REGION



The Lahore Region advances Al-Huda’s vision, “The Qur’an for All- In Every Heart, In Every Hand,” by providing authentic Islamic education through various courses for women, men, and children. It strategically monitors and expands branches, implements policies, and ensures staff training to enhance student enrollment and learning outcomes.

Key initiatives include Sawt al-Qur’an, Fahm-ul-Qur’an, Fiqh-ul-Ibadat, Tafheem-e-Deen, Tajweed standardization, e-learning programs, and short courses, reaching hundreds of students across multiple venues. The region also promotes religious awareness through lectures, publications, and community programs, impacting over 11,000 participants. Another important initiative is the Basic Education Program which brings Quranic teachings to both literate and illiterate women and girls fostering character, morals, and a lifelong connection with the Qur’an and Sunnah.

Courses Conducted under Lahore Region in 2024-2025




KPK REGION



The KPK/Baluchistan Regional Office oversees 516 Quran classes, aiming to expand Islamic education across urban and rural areas. The office prioritizes outreach to underserved communities including underprivileged girls, street children, prisons, medical colleges, and universities, while mapping the province to identify gaps and ensure Quranic teachings reach every sector.




Challenges include communication gaps, staff shortages, limited funds, cultural restrictions on hostels, competition from other religious courses, and preference for online learning. Despite these, the region continues to pursue its mission of spreading Quranic knowledge, fostering moral development, and promoting community welfare across KPK and Baluchistan.



New initiatives include skill-building programs for female prisoners, departmental filing, and targeted outreach programs.




KARACHI REGION


Karachi Region (Courses)






Hyderabad Region (Long Courses)




Hyderabad Region (Short Courses)




In second year as an independent region, focused efforts were made to strengthen Hyderabad's educational system across both mainstream and rural Basic Education Program areas. A regional team was developed to supervise academic quality, support branches, train in-charges, and guide course planning according to local needs. Regular coordination, class visits across Hyderabad and Sindh, and workshops on Al-Huda's vision and values helped improve teaching and learning, while direct engagement with students especially TQ enhanced connection and oversight.

Low female literacy, limited Urdu use, and weak educational foundations continue to challenge enrolment and staff development. Yet, strong performance in Hostel-Based Courses, our key strength, stands out.

No. of Students



From 2023 to 2025, HB Summer Courses experienced a remarkable 65% growth, reflecting rising community interest, improved programming, and strong trust in HB's consistent venue and timing. Mother participation remained stable with a gradual increase in overall engagement, highlighting the recognition of HB's family-inclusive approach. Teacher involvement also expanded from 25 to 35, supported by better training, enhanced resources, and increased volunteer participation. The steady demand for weekly courses, with consistently high attendance over several months, further demonstrates deep learner engagement. Together, these trends confirm that HB's content development, training processes, and management systems are effectively meeting the evolving educational needs of the community.



ACS maintains quality through regular head office visits, monthly evaluations, lesson reviews, and continuous classroom monitoring.





A Journey from DARKNESS TO HOPE

The Story of Three Brave Children



In Nowshera, a family overwhelmed by poverty faced a heartbreaking tragedy that left three young brothers orphaned. After their father and aunt attempted to end their lives in the Kabul River, only the aunt survived. The loss shook the community and forever changed the lives of Muhammad Shahzaib, Muhammad Faizyab, and Muhammad Mustafa.

When these children arrived at Al-Huda Guloona Nowshehra, they carried deep grief but also remarkable resilience. With dedicated care, counseling, and a nurturing environment, the boys slowly began to rebuild their lives. Today, all three brothers are enrolled in school and progressing with confidence.

What began as a story of loss has transformed into a story of hope. With the support of our institution, these children have found stability, dignity, and a new sense of belonging. Their journey is a powerful reminder that with compassion and opportunity, even the darkest moments can lead to bright new beginnings.

 <p>Water Provision</p>	<p>Across the country, arrangements are made to provide clean drinking water in remote areas by digging wells as needed, installing tube wells or boring systems, and setting up electric water coolers and hand pumps.</p>
 <p>Al-Huda Dastarkhwan</p>	<p>This project is unique in the sense that along with providing meals, it also includes arrangements for religious education and training.</p>
 <p>Ramadhan Support Program</p>	<p>During the month of Ramadan, large-scale financial assistance is provided to the poor and needy members of society. In some locations, arrangements are also made for providing Suhur and Iftar meals.</p>
 <p>Eid ul Adhha Qurbani Project</p>	<p>In various regions across the country, Qurbani (sacrifice) is carried out on the occasion of Eid al-Adha, benefiting countless deserving individuals.</p>
 <p>Winter Drive</p>	<p>To protect against severe cold, warm clothing, quilts and dry ration is distributed among needy individuals in various regions.</p>

Plantation Drive

To keep the environment clean and pleasant, fruit-bearing and shade-providing trees are planted in various areas. Plant saplings are also made available at a low cost to encourage students to participate in tree plantation.



Vocational Center

Under the supervision of Al-Huda's various branches, vocational centers have been established to help needy women become self-reliant by teaching them various skills along with education in the Qur'an and Sunnah.



Prisoner Support

Financial assistance is provided for the release of prisoners who are under going sentences solely because they cannot pay fines. Additionally, education and training programs are also arranged for the rehabilitation of female prisoners.



Emergency Relief

In the event of floods, earthquakes, accidents, or any other sudden disaster, immediate assistance is provided to the affected individuals in the form of rations, clothing, tents, and essential supplies. Additionally, houses are constructed for families affected by natural disasters.




Orphanage

Under KPK region, an orphanage named 'Al-Huda Gluna is operating to care for and provide education and training to orphaned children.



NEW INITIATIVES

Al-Huda Institutional Program is a dynamic initiative designed to collaborate with institutions across regions, aiming to bring the message of the Qur'an to every hand and every heart. Through structured programs, training sessions and social welfare activities, this program facilitates the integration of Qur'anic teachings into other Institutions. This initiative works in collaboration with institutions across the country such as educational institutes, hospitals, vocational centers, jails etc. to provide spiritual guidance and work for a better life here and in the Hereafter.



AL-HUDA RABTA DEPARTMENT

ESTABLISHED: SEPTEMBER 2024

The Al-Huda Rabta Department was established in September 2024, marking the 30th year of Al-Huda, to provide a structured platform for connecting Al-Huda graduates across all courses. The department supports continued learning, strengthens alumni relationships, and sustains engagement with the values and knowledge imparted by Al-Huda.

Key Achievements
