Things to do during Ramadan

- * Fasting is a mandatory act of worship; observe it with a pure intention to please Allah .
- * Welcome the month of Ramadan with joy and supplications, and make the following invocation when you see the new moon:

اَللَّهُمَّ اَهُلِلُهُ عَلَيْنَا بِاليُّمُن وَالِّايْمَان وَالسَّلَامَةِ وَالْإِسُلَام رَبَّى وَرَبُّكَ اللَّهُ

O Allah, let this moon (month) pass over us with blessings, Iman, safety, and in the state of Islam. (O Moon!) My Lord and your Lord is Allah.

- * Practice moderation when preparing the meals for *Suhur* and *Iftar* since this is the month of fasting, not feasting.
- * Do istighfar (seek forgiveness), especially at the time of Suhur.
- * Take special care of the tongue and resolve not to speak any ill.
- * Complete the recitation of the Qur'an at least once and make an effort to understand and reflect upon it's meaning.
- * Keep your tongue moist with the remembrance of Allah (*dhikr*) at all times.
- * Make use of your time and energies productively and refrain from useless activities.
- * Ease the workload for servants and employees.
- * Offer voluntary prayers with prolonged recitation and qiyam (standing) as much as possible (especially in tarawih and tahajjud).
- * Yearn and strive to attain Lailah al-Qadr.

Purifying souls

Ibn al Qayyim as said "Origin of all sins are three:

- 1. الكبر (Arrogance): It is that which converted Iblis to what he is.
- 2. الحرص (Greed): It is that which banished Adam الحرص from Jannah.
- 3. الحسد (Jealousy): It is that which incited son of Adam هي against his brother.

The one who is protected from the evil of these three, he is protected from evil; so kufr is due to arrogance; and sins are due to greed; and injustice and oppression are due to jealousy".

Sahih al-Bukhari Sessions
